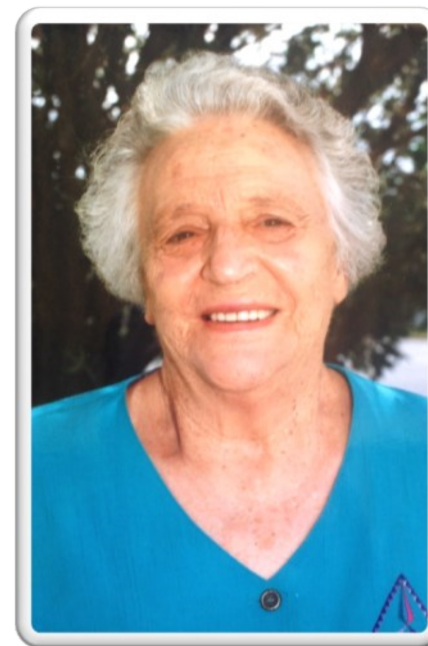




Memorial Service of Thanksgiving for the life of
